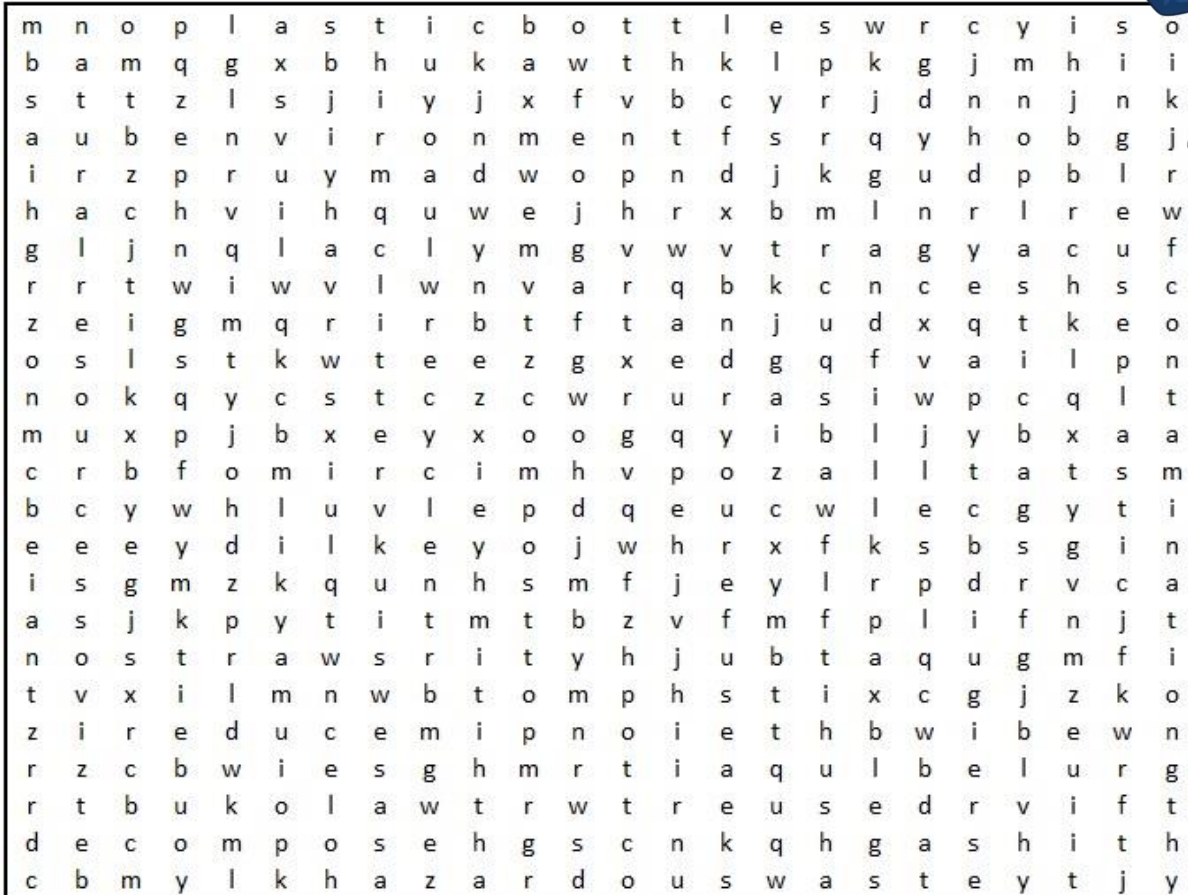

Know what to throw! Putting the wrong things in with your recycling increases the contamination and does more harm than good! Check the lid on your cart or go to our website for a list of what's accepted.

Leave it loose! Don't bag your recycling.

Plastic shopping bags don't go in your recycling! They tangle the sorting machines. Either take them back to the grocery store, or bring your own reusable bags when you shop!

Refuse single-use plastics like straws, bottles, and bags. They're used once then last in the environment forever!

Use reusable bottles and bags to reduce our waste!

Instead of throwing them away, you can compost food scraps and yard waste to make nutrient rich soil for your gardens!
